3.1.2 If revenue of the year is lower than 10,000,000/- (10 million), a copy of financial statement submitted to Maldives Inland Revenue Authority (MIRA)

Note:

i) If the applicant business registered duration is less than 3 years, the financial documents from the business registered date can be submitted-

ii) Financial reports made by a foreign party, not registered in the MIRA should be attested by a registered law firm/lawyer as per (iii), attesting that the document is a true translation and the party is authorized in the respective country of origin-

iii) Projects completed/started/ongoing by 12th October 2020 as per Contractor Regulation amendment 3 (2020/R-97) can be counted only if project license was obtained-
